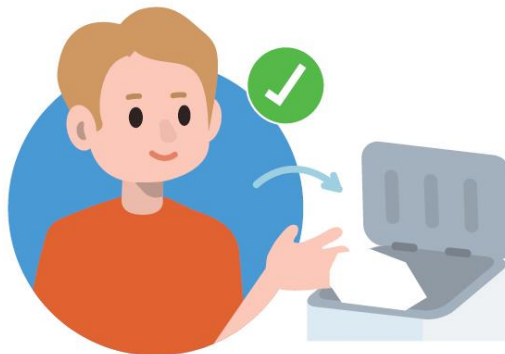
HELP STOP THE SPREAD
