Year 6 WEMG Course

Year 6 WEMG course will commence on **Saturday, 26th April 2025**. This will require a significant commitment of 4 hours module work each week in Writing, English, Maths and General Ability due to the nature of the advanced curriculum. The course aims to help students to build a solid foundation for their independent school scholarship tests.

- The writing module teaches students the most efficient ways in organising writing structure with a focus on developing critical thinking and reasoning skills.
- English lesson will focus on reading skills and practising reading comprehension and multiple-choice questions.
- Mathematics lessons are essential for students to thoroughly understand mathematical theories, principles and formulas to solve problems.
- General Ability lessons will cover a variety of practical, challenging and mind-stimulating questions including verbal and non-verbal reasoning.
